The presentation uses the layout pioneered by Edward Tufte<sup>1</sup> and runs with **Pandoc**. Pandoc makes it possible to produce from the same text (in Markdown format) the HTML for the web presentation and a pdf, which is usually easier for reading a paper copy.

The text should adapt to the screen width<sup>2</sup> - and will be further improved with images.

The presentation requires some more fine tuning and fixing differences in formatting, which emerged over the years of writing.
